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Dear all!

We are happy to announce the launch of the **“Be A Manager” e-learning platform** which aims to provide adult learners and educators, especially women employed in textile companies, with a complete training package for managerial skills highly relevant to the textile sector needs, integrated into an e-learning format.

The features of self-evaluation and the possibility of downloading content in raw format will encourage both customized and self-regulated learning, as well as the adjustment of the training content based on the training needs of adult educators. Thus, women will be equipped with the managerial skills (leadership, crisis management, teamwork) needed to claim senior managerial positions within the textile industry.

## Be a Manager Platform

There are **12 training modules**, carefully designed to attract the users' interest and engagement with the comprehensive training content, including also self-assessment quizzes, all integrated into the e-learning format. Upon completion of the whole “Be a Manager” course, users will be able to take a final quiz that includes questions from all modules to assess the knowledge acquired. **The successful completion of this quiz will lead to the issuing of a Certificate of Completion for the user.**

For adult educators, the platform includes these modules in editable format, containing also practical activities that will be a valuable tool for those training women as adult learners, which can be also used by the latter for personal assessment and self-reflection.

The “Be a Manager” platform is available in 6 languages, in addition to the English one; namely, in Swedish, French, Italian, Spanish, Greek, and Ukrainian.
